



2017 – INCOME GUIDELINES FOR BRIEF ADVICE CLINICS

“Income” includes all household income, including employment, disability, welfare, social security, SSI, alimony, workers’ and unemployment comp, child support, VA, pension or retirement

250% of the Federal Poverty Guidelines - To receive a free consultation, individuals must have total gross household income under 250% FPL or be a senior (age 60+)

200% FPL - *Clients referred to LASC for extended service must generally have income below 200%.
